Campsite

One of the best ways to enjoy the festival is to use the Official Festival Campsite. With lovely views across the valley, it's the perfect place to get into the great festival community vibe.

Hot showers, toilets and running water are provided on-site. We have a designated family camping area which quiets down after 10:30pm. Because the campsite is on the edge of the town we also lay on a great value bus service so you can travel to and from the site safely. A food stall will be on site to provide breakfasts and late-night snacks, as well as goodies throughout the day.

The campsite is restricted to full week, weekend and day season ticket holders for the appropriate night(s), Supporters Club members and people who have bought event tickets in advance, for the night(s) of the event(s) only. Camping is free for children under 12 if accompanied by an adult. Family camping tickets are valid for two adults and up to three youths.

The campsite is mainly for tents but there is space for a limited number of caravans and motor-homes, so book early!

Access for People with Disabilities

Wheelchair access is available at most venues and our volunteer stewards are always ready to assist with any particular needs. Registered disabled customers may apply in writing for a free Companion's Ticket.

Supporters Club

Membership entitles you to buy a Ham evening season ticket and to buy a ticket for the Festival Campsite, plus admission to the Saturday morning welcome concert. You'll also get a free copy of the Working Programme. You can join until 30th April for a minimum annual donation of £25. We are always looking for volunteers who can spare some time to steward the events during the week in return for a complimentary ticket. Please visit the website for further information. Our volunteers are the backbone of the festival and your time will be greatly appreciated.

What ticket should I buy?

That all depends on how you plan to enjoy the festival! If you want the flexibility to pick and choose a variety of events throughout the week without having to buy lots of individual event tickets, and at the best possible value, then the **SEASON TICKET** is for you. It gets you into all the ceilidhs, workshops, Bulverton evening gigs, dances, Late Night Extras, concerts at the Bedford Hotel and Manor Pavilion, afternoons at the Ham Marquee, and lots more, plus it gives you priority admission over people who want to pay on the door. As a season ticket holder you will also get a discount on tickets for individual evening concerts at the Ham Marquee. If you don't want to pick and choose between all those great headliners in the Ham evening concerts, you can buy a **HAM EVENING SEASON** to add to your full week Season Ticket and get even better value.

Can I buy a Ham Evening Season Ticket without buying a full week's Season Ticket?

We aim to be as flexible as possible in our ticketing, and the **HAM EVENING SEASON** offers fantastic value to those who want to attend the evening headline concerts in the Ham without buying a full Season Ticket. By joining the **Sidmouth Supporters Club** (details overleaf), you can buy the Ham Evening Season ticket on its own, as well as gaining access to the official Festival Campsite.

I've never been to Sidmouth before, but I'm going to be in Devon and thought I might come along for a day. Is there a ticket for me?

The **DAY SEASON TICKET** gives you 1-day access to all the events of the ordinary Season Ticket, with the same priority admission privileges. You can also top it up with a ticket for that night's concert in the Ham. The **DAY SEASON TICKET** even gives you access to the official Festival Campsite, so you can enjoy the Bulverton LNE event without worrying about driving home!

Of course, there are individual event tickets for many of our events (available from the end of May), so if you just want to dip in and out of a few concerts, ceilidhs or workshops, that's always an option, too.

What if we want to come for the weekend?

Then the **WEEKEND SEASON TICKET** is for you. It gives you access to all the events of the ordinary Season Ticket from Friday through Sunday. You can also buy a **WEEKEND CAMPING TICKET** which offers you discounted access to the official Festival Campsite from Friday through Sunday night.

Are there tickets to suit families?

We love families at Sidmouth! There is a range of offers to help families enjoy the festival: kids under 7 come for free, and older children can enjoy a whole day at the festival from as little as £7, £14 for the weekend or £35 for the whole week. There is a **FAMILY CAMPING TICKET** for the week, and children under 12 camp for free.

What if I want to pick and choose individual events?

You can buy individual tickets to most things, though not all are available to buy in advance. Many popular events will sell out in advance, so if there's something you really want to see, book early. You can buy on-line or from Sidmouth TIC before the festival, as well as from our Box Office kiosk during FolkWeek. **Tickets for individual events go on sale at the end of May.**
